Myron Orfield is a Professor of Law at the University of Minnesota and the Director of the Institute of Metropolitan Opportunity. The Institute investigates the ways that laws, policies and practices affect development patterns in U.S. metropolitan regions, with a focus on the growing social and economic disparities within



these areas. He has written books, chapters, and articles on spatial inequality, fair housing, school desegregation, open enrollment, and charter schools, to name a few. Professor Orfield's research has led to legislative and judicial reforms at the federal level and state level reform in Minnesota and several other states.

He is a graduate of the University of Minnesota, and currently teaches a course on the legislative process.
